In history time is divided into TWO periods

Years AFTER Christ's birth. They go FORWARDS from the birth of Jesus 1AD to 2013 AD -Today

Years before Christ's birth. They go BACKWARDS from the birth of Jesus

Historians often look at events over long periods of time—Often over CENTURIES (A century = \_\_\_\_\_ years)

If you are 11 years old it means that you have lived for 11 complete years and are now in your 12<sup>th</sup> year. A newborn baby is 0 years old but is living in its first year.

We count the centuries in the same way. Here are some examples:

- The 21<sup>st</sup> century includes all the years that start with 20 because there have been 20 complete centuries and now the 21<sup>st</sup> is happening.
- The year 1666 is in the 17<sup>th</sup> century.
- The 19<sup>th</sup> century includes the year 1815.

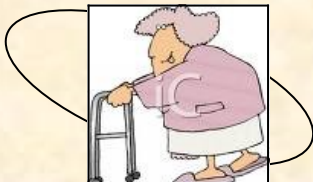
